Tilos

The Tilos Collection takes inspiration from the archetypal seating of the 1950s and 1960s, traditionally crafted in bamboo and rattan. These forms have been reimagined using advanced technologies and modern industrial manufacturing techniques, resulting in a collection that feels both timeless and contemporary.

At its core, Tilos features a distinctive shell made of metal and woven acrylic rope, designed to cradle plush cushions while ensuring both comfort and durability. This shell rests on a structural frame available in either wood or metal, offering a refined and versatile foundation. The design seamlessly allows for the interchangeability of these base materials, adapting to different aesthetic and functional needs.

The collection also includes dining chairs available in two versions—one stackable for greater flexibility and another with armrests for enhanced comfort.

With Tilos, the goal was to merge tradition and innovation, seamlessly blending artisanal references with the precision of contemporary industrial craftsmanship to create pieces that integrate effortlessly into modern spaces.



























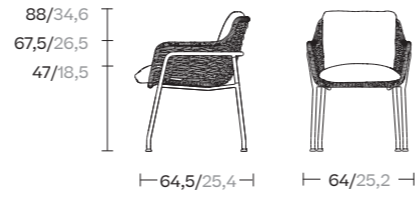

Alize, by Vincent Van Duysen

Alize is a modular outdoor collection by Vincent Van Duysen that balances architectural clarity with a relaxed and inviting sense of comfort. Inspired by the spirit of coastal living and informed by the attitude of the Malibu series by Frédéric Méchiche for Hugonet, the collection embraces simplicity, lightness and an optimistic way of inhabiting outdoor environments. A continuous tubular frame defines each piece with a precise yet fluid line, creating a light architectural

presence that is both distinctive and timeless. This structural clarity is softened by generous cushions and tactile upholstery, establishing a refined dialogue between line and volume, structure and softness. Conceived as a flexible system, Alize allows for seamless compositions that adapt naturally to a variety of outdoor settings, from expansive terraces to more intimate spaces.



















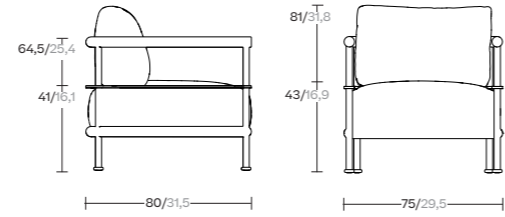






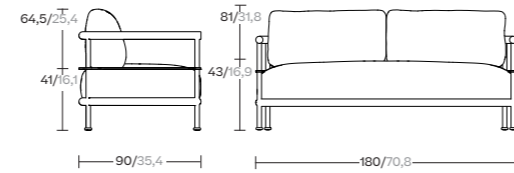

Atlantic, by Jasper Morrison

The Atlantic collection, designed by Jasper Morrison for Kettal, marks a sophisticated return to the essence of form. Inspired by the skeletal purity of the Thinking Man's Chair, Atlantic is a masterclass in "all structure, no closed surfaces"—a design that breathes.

Produced with the technical precision of Hugonet, the collection transforms linear geometry into a language of comfort. By stripping away the superfluous, Morrison allows light, air, and the surrounding landscape to become part of the furniture itself. It is a dialogue between solid and void, where the rhythm of the lines creates a calm yet distinct architectural silhouette.

Atlantic does not shout for attention; it commands it through restraint. It is a quiet intervention for terraces and gardens, where durability meets an effortless visual lightness. In collaboration with Hugonet, Kettal delivers more than just seating—it delivers an atmosphere of clarity, designed to support the ritual of outdoor living for years to come.



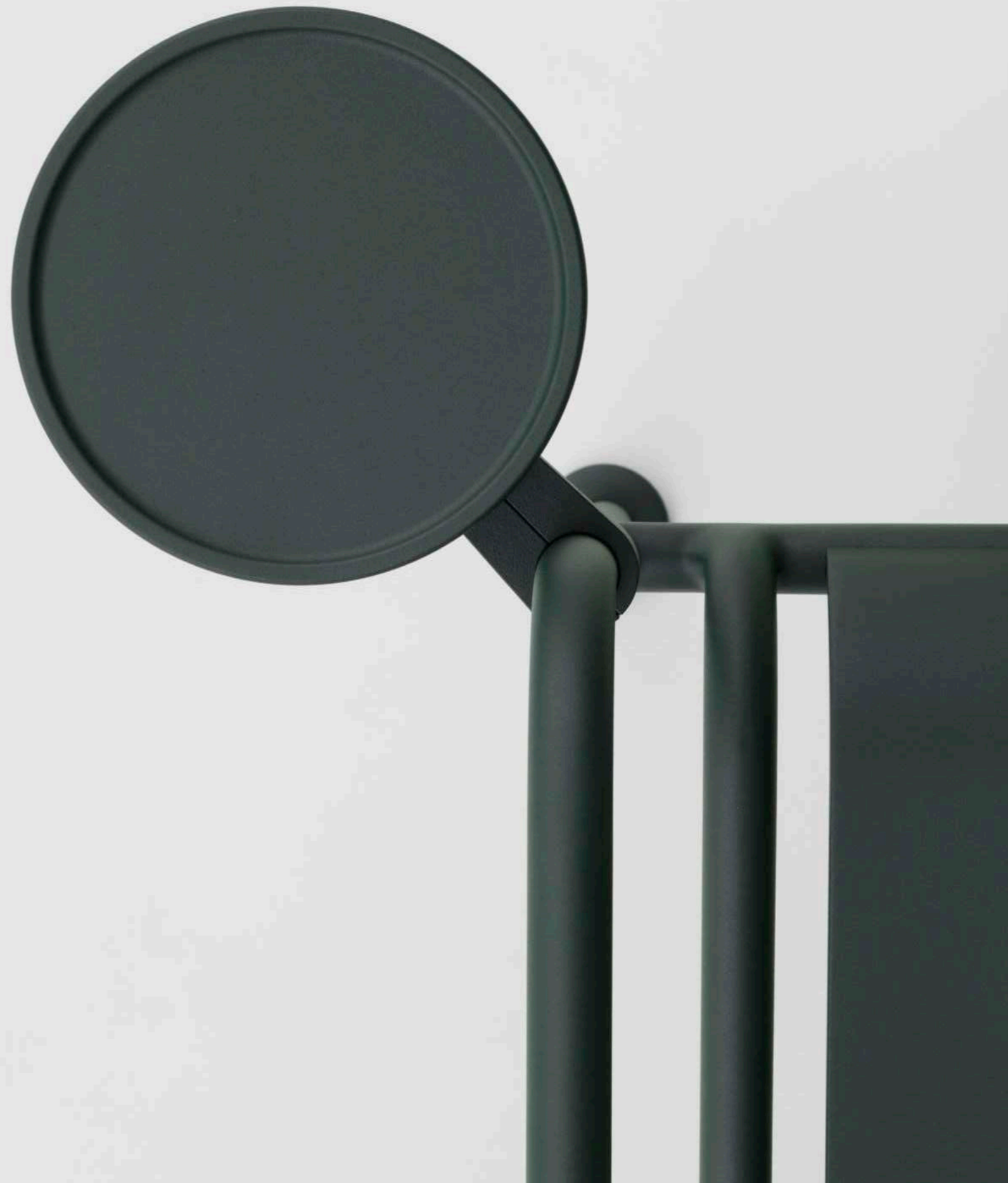


















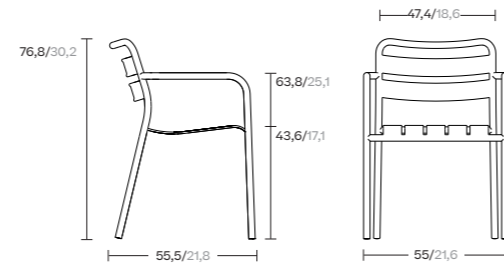

Grosso, by Patricia Urquiola

Grosso is not merely a sofa—it is a living sculpture where meticulous precision and organic flow coexist. Every curve and fold is the result of ergonomic mastery, an invitation to experience comfort as a true art form.

Its surface, a tapestry of rhythmic patchwork stitching, beckons you to surrender to its plush embrace or engage with its subtle rotation. Beneath its grand, pouf-like silhouette lies a sophisticated architecture of varying foam densities. This hidden engineering allows for a natural deformation that responds to the body, ensuring the piece grows more personal and beloved over time.

With sculptural audacity and a playful spirit, Grosso challenges conventional design. It transforms effortlessly from a languid daybed to an introspective armchair or a structured modular system. In Grosso, art and comfort are inseparable—a celebration of spontaneity guided by precision, and a canvas where life unfolds with quiet poetry.









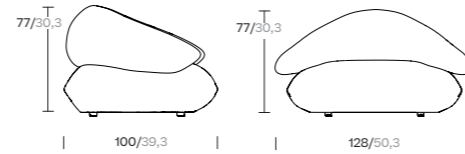






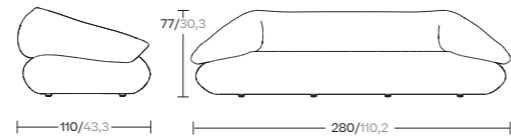

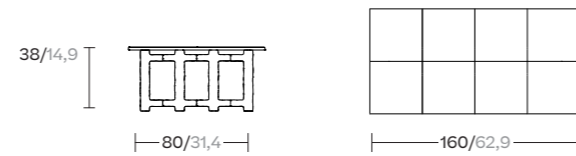

Globo, by Miguel Milá

Kettal reintroduces Globo (1965), the iconic lighting design by Miguel Milá and a landmark of 20th century design.

Winner of the Delta de Oro, its essence lies in a pure, frosted polyethylene sphere crafted through pioneering blow molding, achieving a perfectly balanced, luminous form.

The sphere is paired with a black injected plastic base and refined brass lampholder, reflecting Milá's honest use of materials.

Updated by Kettal in four sizes (17, 30, 40, 60 cm) and adapted for outdoor use, Globo offers a soft, diffused light suited to diverse environments.

A timeless design that combines industrial precision with warmth.

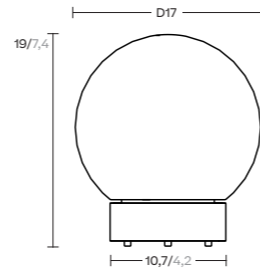




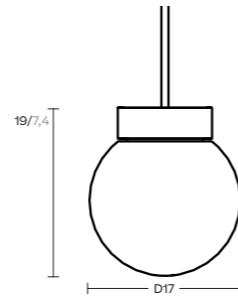




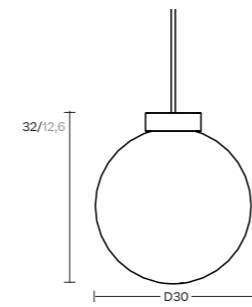

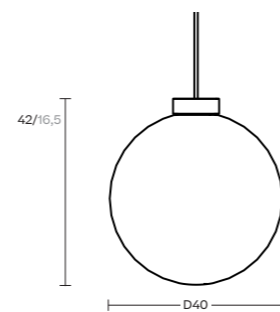
D17 Suspension
