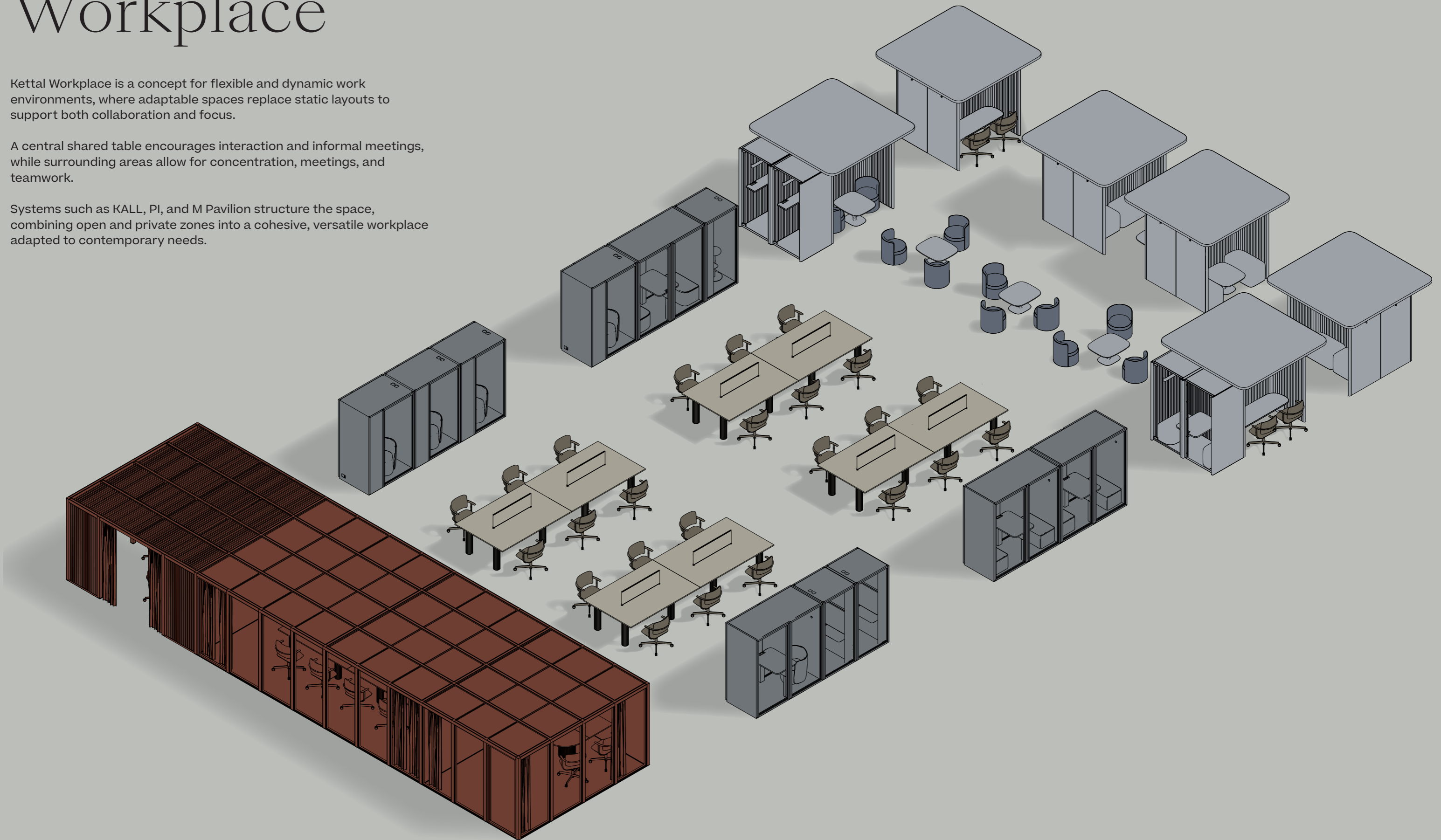

Workplace

Kettal Workplace is a concept for flexible and dynamic work environments, where adaptable spaces replace static layouts to support both collaboration and focus.

A central shared table encourages interaction and informal meetings, while surrounding areas allow for concentration, meetings, and teamwork.

Systems such as KALL, PI, and M Pavilion structure the space, combining open and private zones into a cohesive, versatile workplace adapted to contemporary needs.





U-Type by Barber Osgerby

Kettal presents U-Type, a new chair by Edward Barber & Jay Osgerby that rethinks the office chair through clarity, comfort and quiet design.

As workplaces become more hybrid and informal, seating is moving away from visible mechanisms towards simpler forms that conceal performance.

U-Type embodies this shift. Its die-cast aluminium frame forms a continuous U-shape that supports the backrest and armrests, creating a fluid, architectural structure.

Soft, oversized cushions add comfort and familiarity, balancing the clarity of the aluminium frame. Ergonomic performance is discreetly integrated through a synchronised mechanism hidden beneath the seat.

With U-Type, Kettal creates more relaxed and welcoming work environments where performance and informality coexist.



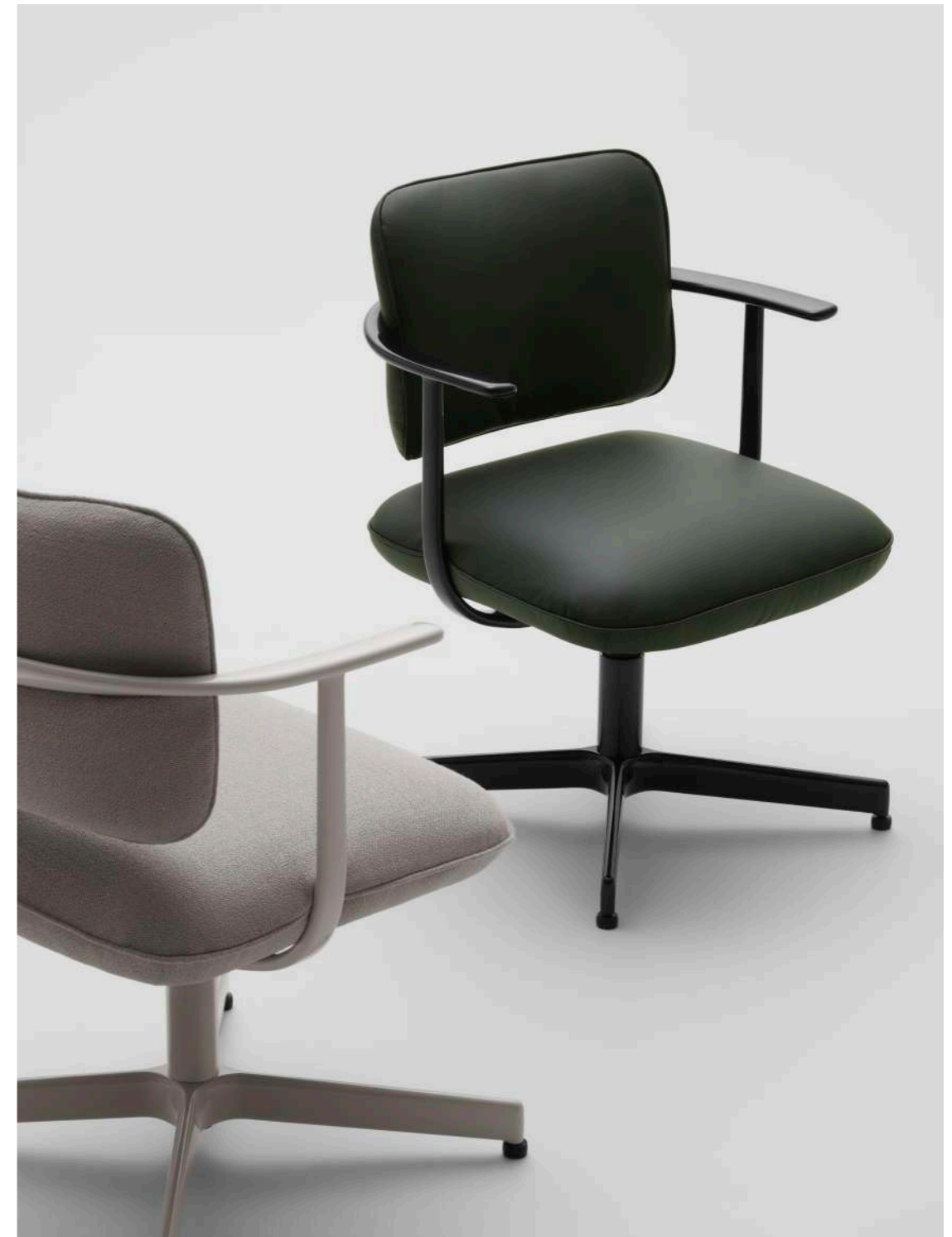

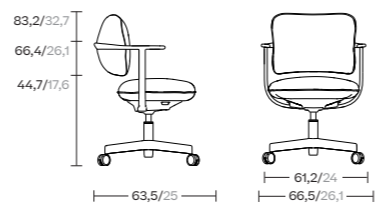




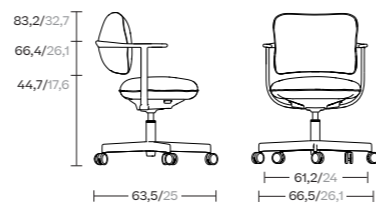
Office chair 4 legs

Shogun by Verner Panton

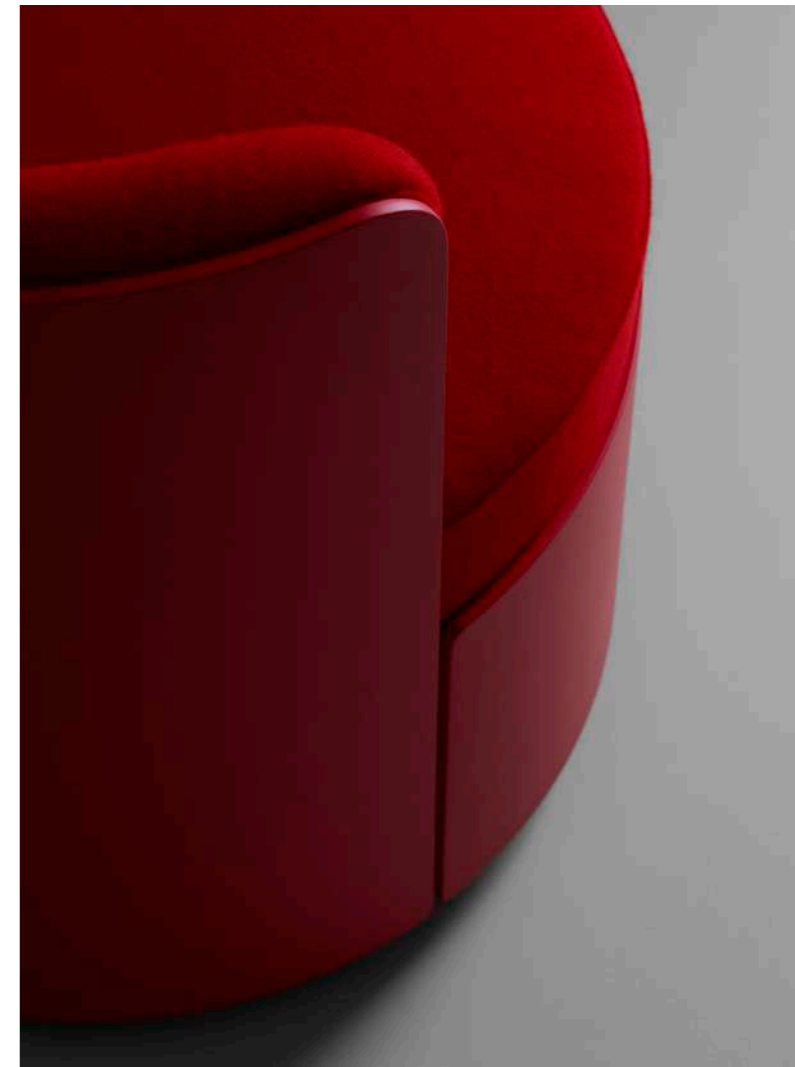
